♥ **COUP DE CŒUR 16/20** - "A red fruit nose with vanilla and fruity scents on the palate. A wine with good structure, fresh, voluptuous, lively to the finish, nice fruit, very elegant" Tasting Jacques Dupont, Primeurs 2016

**89/100** - "Crimson colour with streaks of violet. The nose is very expressive, marked by notes of flowers like violets. Juvenile character; the wine gains in complexity after airing. It is quite sharp on the palate, full of character and pure. A lively juicy wine, very interesting and surprising. To be followed while ageing. I find it full of promise" Novembre 2018

**91pts** - "A ripe, succulent and supple wine for this appellation with a fresh, minty finish that makes it stand out in the crowd. I love the full, fresh-blackberry bouquet. Pure merlot. Drink or hold." Feb19

**JEB DUNNUCK 89pts** "The ruby/purple-colored 2016 Château Flaunys comes from sandier soils and is all Merlot raised in a mix of barrels and tank. It has a sweetly fruited, medium-bodied, charming style as well as notes of black raspberries, cedary spice, ripe cherries, and underbrush. With good tension and purity on the palate, the elegant style of the vintage, and plenty of character, it's a terrific little Saint-Emilion to drink over the coming decade or so." (28/02/2019)
