Formerly, in the noble families, the first son inherited the estate, the second became a priest, and the CADET learned the art of fight. Nowadays, in a family, the CADET is the latest born child, the youngest. The wine produced by the younger vines is named CADET. Its structure, elegant and delicate needs a shorter maturing.



VINEYARD

All of our plots are cultivated with the respect for environment and full expression of the terroir: low level of treatment, frequent tillage, systematic leaf-thinning, green harvesting, sorting.

The "younger brother" of Château la Claymore is produced from the young vines of the estate under 12 years, planted at the foot of the hillside on medium and heavy clay soils, and giving wines with palpable fruity notes (red berries), supple on the palate with a fresh finish..





WINE

Wine making process is made without the use of SO₂, under temperature control during fermentation and maceration. Grape must tasted and selected for CADET, after the running off and pressing, ages partly in tanks (80%) and partly under alternative oak (staves).

Bottled after 18 months' ageing, CADET is available in 75cl Bordeaux bottles



TASTING

Nice deep purple colour. The nose is full of finesse, opening up with notes of dark fruits such as blackcurrant and blackberry. On the palate it is structured by silky and fine tannins which give elegance and purety.

Ideal to accompany grilled meats of a great meal of chicken.
