90-92pts - "Nose of black cherry, raspberry, very floral. Fleshy in the mouth, juicy with a beautiful velvety texture with roundness and a nice freshness. Round and greedy" Yohan Castaing, Primeurs 2018 (18/04/2019).



88-89pts - "A purplished-crimson colour. Youth aromas, refreshing with notes of peppermint and eucalyptus. I also note some delicious scents of blackberries. Luscious and juicy attack, charming. A balanced wine which may already be drunk although the fine and compact tannins tend to be late in coming and hold out promise for the future. To be continued! 86-88pts - "Composed of 65% Merlot, 15% Cabernet Franc and 20% Malbec, the deep garnet-purple colored 2018 La Claymore is a little closed, offering broody tilled soil, tar and chargrill notes over a baked plums, blackberry pie and hoisin core. Mediumbodied, the palate is firm and chewy in the mouth with reticent fruit and an earthy finish "Robert Parker, Wine Advocate (23/04/2019)
