
14,5/20 - "Black fruits, round and supple palate, fine tannins, quite silky, dense body, tannins of good quality, beautiful fruit" Jacques Dupont, En-primeur tasting

88-90pts "Composed of 85% Merlot and 15% Cabernet Franc, the deep garnet-purple colored 2018 Flaunys has quite a spicy nose with a core of black cherries and mulberries plus hints of dusty soil and dried herbs.

15+/20 89-90/100 - "The nose is fruity and offers a small richness as well as small intensity. Its reveals notes of pulpy cassis, ripe Boysen berry, small notes of fleshy/juicy violet plum associated with touches of strawberry as well as hints of fresh lily, fine hints of liquorice and a very discreet hint of grey pepper. The palate is fruity, well-balanced and offers a juicy/acidulous frame, minerality, a fine tension as well as a pulpy/juicy/very discreetly tight fruit. On the palate this wine expresses notes of pulpy/juicy red berries associated with fine hints of juicy violet plum as well as hints of lily/lilac and very discreet hints of toasted almond. Good length. Tannins are well-built. A small tension on the finish. A iodine hint and cocoa on the finish/persistence." VertdeVin magazine&Website (hiver 2021)
