VertoeVin 15/20 - 89-90/100 - " - The nose is fruity and offers freshness as well as a certain concentration. It reveals notes of juicy/ripe cassis, juicy blackberry, small notes of crushed raspberry associated with touches of small crunchy/juicy berries as well as fine hints of nutmeg and a very discreet hint of fresh lilac. The palate is fresh, juicy and offers minerality, a linear/stretch side and a small mineral frame. On the palate this wine expresses notes of juicy/fresh cassis, juicy/fresh blackberry, small notes of violet associated with touches of small crunchy/juicy red berries, fresh lilac as well as subtle hints of nutmeg, a racy minerality and a very discreet hint of caramelized almond.
