







Primeurs Bordeaux 2020 Tasting notes

CHATEAU CILORN 2020 BORDEAUX SUPERIEUR AOC

Score

88-89 pts – James Suckling

May 27, 2021 – A creamy and fruity red with medium body, light and ripe tannins and a fresh finish.

88-90 pts - Yohan Castaing (Anthocyanes)

May 10, 2021 – A very floral nose with violet and iris aromas, almost peony, and a noticeable hint of blackberry and spices. Tense with forthright attack, quite acid, adding a delicate freshness. Fresh finish. May open out after ageing.

84-86 pts - Jeff Leve (The Wine Cellar Insider)

May 20, 2021 – Early drinking, soft, uncomplicated, red berry filled wine with no hard edges and a pleasant finish.

88-90 pts – Jeb Dunnuck

April 6, 2021 – The 2020 Château Cilorn is a nicely textured, charming Bordeaux Supérieur offering medium to full-bodied aromas and flavors of ripe black cherries, mulled spices, and savory herbs. It's a delicious, balanced 2020 to enjoy over the coming decade or so.

89-90 pts – Jonathan Choukroune Chicheportiche (VertdeVin)

The fruity nose combines power and finesse, with some concentration and balance. Notes of pulpy blackberry and crushed raspberry, a discreet pulpy blackcurrant, with a hint of violets, lilies, and delicate hints of soft spices. Also, a subtle scent of vanilla and nutmeg. It is fruity on the palate with a beautiful texture, juicy and fresh, somewhat greedy with a tart structure, mineral and smooth notes. In the mouth the wine reveals notes of pulpy/juicy blackberry, pulpy raspberry and mild pulpy/fresh cherry, mixed with a touch of violets, lilies, liquorice and delicate hints of vanilla and fresh hazelnut. Good length.
