

89-90pts - "The fruity nose combines power and finesse, with some concentration and balance. Notes of pulpy blackberry and crushed raspberry, a discreet pulpy blackcurrant, with a hint of violets, lilies, and delicate hints of soft spices. Also, a subtle scent of vanilla and nutmeg. It is fruity on the palate with a beautiful texture, juicy and fresh, somewhat greedy with a tart structure, mineral and smooth notes. In the mouth the wine reveals notes of pulpy/juicy blackberry, pulpy raspberry and mild pulpy/fresh cherry, mixed with a touch of violets, lilies, liquorice and delicate hints of vanilla and fresh hazelnut.
