Notes of fresh blackberry, ripe small black berries and a discreet scent of violets, with touches of fresh lilac, cherry blossoms and some delicate hints of soft spices and tobacco. The palate is fruity, delicately tight and gives juiciness, minerality, a beautiful texture and fine smoothness, a discreet sense of tension. In the mouth the wine reveals notes of pulpy/juicy blackberry, fresh/ripe raspberry and subtle flavours of small berries mixed with touches of tobacco, fresh nutmeg, a discreet hint of clove and saffron. The tannins are well-defined and quite soft. Good length.”
