CHATEAU LA CLAYMORE 2022

LUSSAC SAINT-EMILION AOC

Score

91-92 pts – James Suckling April 7, 2023 – Some solid fruit in this wine with black berry and fresh herb aromas and flavors. Medium-bodied. Savory and juicy. Well done for the appellation.

90–92 pts – Yves Beck April 13, 2023 – Great delicacy on the nose. Good harmony between the wine maturing and the expression of the fruit. The palate confirms this delicate bouquet. The wine is elegant, harmonious and structured. The finish is fruity and long-lasting, perfectly enhanced by the structure. 2027-2037.

CHATEAU FLAUNYS 2022

MONTAGNE SAINT-EMILION AOC

Score

91–92 pts – James Suckling April 19, 2023 – Firm and lightly chewy with fresh fruit and stony minerality. Medium body. Lengthy.

89-91pts - Yohan Castaing, Robert Parker - Wine Advocate April 28, 2023 – With aromas of ink, lilac, bramble and dark berries, the 2022 Flaunys has a juicy, fresh, charming and enveloping palate with bright acids, aromas of gravel soils and a fresh finish. This is a strong effort and an estate to watch.

90-91pts - Yves Beck April 12, 2023 - Intensely aromatic, Flaunys shows freshness and minerality on the nose, as well as scents of black berries. Good density on the palate, the wine is juicy with vigorous tannins that should become rounded, yet providing good backbone with structural acidity. 2027-2037.

CHATEAU CILORN 2022 BORDEAUX SUPERIEUR AOC

Score

90–92pts – Yves Beck April 11, 2023 – The bouquet gradually gives up precise notes of fruits and minerality, with nuanced scents of eucalyptus. The wine is fine and lightly creamy, with a beautiful supporting acidity and good tannins. Juicy and fruity, with a long and fresh finish. 2027-2037.
