Formerly, in the noble families, the first son inherited the estate, the second became a priest, and the **CADET** learned the art of fight. Nowadays, in a family, the **CADET** is the latest born child, the youngest. The wine produced by the younger vines is named **CADET**. Its structure, elegant and delicate needs a shorter maturing.

VINEYARD



All of our plots are cultivated with the respect for environment and full expression of the terroir: low level of treatment, frequent tillage, systematic leaf-thinning, green harvesting, sorting.



The "younger brother" of Château la Claymore is produced from the young vines of the estate under 12 years, planted at the foot of the hillside on medium and heavy clay soils, and giving wines with palpable fruity notes (red berries), supple on the palate with a fresh finish.



Two varieties: MERLOT mostly, CABERNET FRANC

WINE



Wine making process is made without the use of SO_2 , under temperature control during fermentation and maceration. Grape must tasted and selected for **CADET**, after the running off and pressing, ages partly in tanks (80%) and partly under alternative oak (staves).



Bottled after 18 months' ageing, **CADET** is available in 75cl Bordeaux bottles.

TASTING



A beautiful intense ruby colour, with some subtle poppy red reflections. It has a pretty discreet nose of blackcurrant buds and peony. The wine is fresh and delicate on the palate, with fruity notes of redcurrant.



Ideal to accompany grilled meats of a great meal of chicken.
