



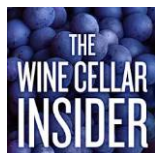

### CHATEAU FLAUNYS 2022



**90pts** - "Produced from 100% Merlot, the wine is round, supple, creamy, and fruity, with a soft-textured, juicy, fruity, cherry, and plum finish that holds your focus. Drink from 2022-2035."

**90-91pts** - "Intensely aromatic, Flaunys shows freshness and minerality on the nose, as well as scents of black berries. **JAMES SUCKLING.COM** **91pts** - "Lots of ripe plum and cherry fruit on the nose, accompanied by olives and seaweed. It's full-bodied with salty and mineral undertones to the creamy fruit. Youthful. Merlot. Try from 2027."

**91-92pts** - "Firm and lightly chewy with fresh fruit and stony minerality. Medium body. Lengthy" James Suckling, Primeurs 2022 (19 April, 2023)



**89-91pts** - "With aromas of ink, lilac, bramble and dark berries, the 2022 Flaunys has a juicy, fresh, charming and enveloping palate with bright acids, aromas of gravel soils and a fresh finish. This is a strong effort and an estate to watch".

**92pts** - "(100% Merlot). The wine has a deep ruby color and fully ripe fruit aromas of black plum, juicy sour cherry, wild strawberry, raspberry jam, red currant jelly, with a discreet hint of wood (liquorice, a touch of black chocolate, roasted hazelnut and some smoke on the background, nutmeg, liquorice). There is also some hint of kirsch and prune on the background, combined with delicate, elegant aromas of rose and peony. The mouth is smooth, airy and juicy with expressive flavours of sour cherry, but also notes of black plum, blackberry, crushed wild strawberry, kirsch and raspberry coulis, with a greedy spicy woodiness (liquorice, white pepper, cardamom on the background, a roasted hint of hazelnut and wood). The tannins are well-shaped, supple and fine but structured. Good bitterness, lingering notes of rosemary and violet, with bright and mouth-watering acidity". VertdeVin (December, 2024)
