1 star - " This merlot from Fronsac molass shows the sustained colour of this vintage and gives nuanced aromas of ripe fruit and spices, as well as roasting scents on the nose which linger on the palate. The mouth is nicely harmonious and has a charming soft texture with fine tannins and persistent freshness. "
