



CHATEAU MOULIN DE FONTMUREE 2020

LUSSAC SAINT-EMILION AOC

More than one hundred years ago on the Estate, a mill with a rotating wheel used water directly from a little river to mill wheat into flour. François LINARD and his wife have renovated this small hamlet named **MOULIN DE FONTMURÉE**, including a house with barn. This name was given to the Estate's second wine..



VINEYARD

All of our plots are cultivated with the respect for environment and full expression of the terroir: low level of treatment, frequent tillage, systematic leaf-thinning, green harvesting, sorting.

MOULIN DE FONTMUREE is produced from low-lying growing vines located in the clayey hills near the mill pond.

MERLOT mostly, CABERNET FRANC and MALBEC

WINE

Wine making process is made without the use of SO₂, under temperature control during fermentation and maceration. Grape must tasted and selected for **MOULIN DE FONTMUREE**, after the running off and pressing, ages during 18 months.

Bottled after 18 months' ageing, **MOULIN DE FONTMUREE** is available in 75cl Bordeaux bottles.

TASTING

A brilliant colour of deep red with purple tints. On the nose the wine is fruity with cherry and wild strawberry notes, enhanced by tones of white pepper. Fresh and silky mouth with well-balanced tannins and a lingering finish of blackberry and toffee.

Ideal to accompany grilled meats or a great meal of chicken, a well-aged Comté cheese.
